## 2010 HANGAR 111 AEMC SPRINT CHAMPIONSHIP – BULLETIN 2

I am pleased to say that we started the first round at North Weald with 70 registered competitors and still a few more promised, so we should at least match last years level of registrations. Of the 70 registered contenders a healthy 31 took part at a rather cold North Weald a couple of weeks ago.

For those that were a bit late in registering and especially those that are new to the championship you may find that some Clubs have already sent out their event supplementary regulations. However you can find all the event regulations on the sprint championship page of the AEMC web site. Also, on the same page you will find the championship points table – which will be updated at regular intervals throughout the season.

For those that were not at the season opener at North Weald I enclose the championship stickers and for the most recent registered contenders' championship registration cards. If after getting this bulletin you find you are missing anything please let me know.

The 2010 championship rule changes have received a mixed response, with some people voting with the feet and not competing, whilst others have voted with their wallets and bought new tyres or changed cars etc. What is evident at present is that the road-going classes are popular but the modified classes are less so. When the local association championship co-ordinators got together last year to finalise the rules for this year we were lead to believe there was very little scope for modifying the MSA rules. However that has been clarified in a number of respects, which if known earlier we may well have had some different classes. I would be interested in your views about the rules and anything you would like to see in the future so that we can get a draft set of 2011 championship rules out for discussion by early September. So let me know your thoughts.
