The event offers 44 miles of forestry stages linked by a road route of 100 miles and is a round of the Silverstone Tyres BTRDA Rally Series incorporating the BTRDA Gold Star®, BTRDA Silver Star® and the Millers Oils BTRDA 1400 Championships plus the BTRDA Rally First Challenge and the MG ZR Rally Challenge. It is also part of the MSA English Rally Championship and four prestigious Regional Association Championships - the Competition Car Insurance EMAMC Championship, the Roadrunner Phoenix Awards ANEMMC Championship, the Fostek Engineering ANCC Championship and the Ward Construction AEMC Championship.

As part of the celebration of the 50th event we have included two classes for Historic Cars and we hope to see some of the cars from past Dukeries Rallies on the event.

Thanks to the continued support of Competitors and Sponsors we have retained the **standard entry fee at £375**. To encourage competitors to sample forest rallying we have a **reduced entry fee of £325** to any driver entering their first forest rally and to all BTRDA Rally First crews.

We have introduced an on-line entries system and would encourage competitors to make use of the service although postal entries are always welcome. For those who require Saturday Scrutineering there will be a short session available 'by appointment', and to encourage competitors to enter in good time we guarantee a full refund if an entry is withdrawn up to one week before the event.
