LIVE TV AT MARGAM PARK

The final stage of the event, SS18 Margam Park 2, will be broadcast live around the world, which is a first for World Rallying. On board cameras, helicopter cameras and static cameras in stage will be used to produce the footage and hopefully crown the 2003 World Rally Champion on live global tv.
